Superintendent Morrison invited Director of Learning Kuemper to report on the findings from the consultations. Director Kuemper stated that almost every stakeholder supported teaching meaningful lessons during school to ensure all students are engaged in learning. Teaching and learning should happen before and after September 30th, and throughout the year, with September 30th being a non instructional day to symbolize the meaning and purpose of the national holiday, demonstrate support for

Indigenous communities as a Catholic district, and to provide stakeholders with the opportunity to honour the day in a meaningful way

Superintendent Morrison reported on a host of reasons for why commemorating the day out of school is the best way to honour Truth and Reconciliation. As a result, Dr. Morrison and his senior team strongly recommend that CTR Catholic commemorates the day with a day out of school.

Discussion followed and trustees were supportive of National Truth and Reconciliation Day being a day out of school.

Harry Salm (Strathmore) moved:

that the Board of Trustees of Christ the Redeemer Catholic Separate School Division approves September 30, 2021, being a day out of school in recognition of the National Truth and Reconciliation Day, to "honour the survivors of residential schools, their families and communities and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process".

Chair Keenan (Foothills County) led the group in a Closing Prayer.
